- 3. Who does this role report to?
- 4. How long can someone hold this role?
- 5. Call or Email the Person in the Role.
 - a. Send them a specific question.
 - b. What are their plans or goals while in the role?
 - c. Interview Them.
- 6. What goal(s) this person achieved in this role?
- 7. Who currently holds this role?
 - a. Biography
 - b. How long have they held the role?
 - c. How long is their term?
 - d. What role did they have prior to this role?
- 8. Who previously held the role?
- 9. Why do citizens need to know about the role?
